



## MASHATU GAME RESERVE - FACT SHEET 2011/12

### WHERE IS MASHATU GAME RESERVE?

- South East Botswana directly on the border with South Africa, & Zimbabwe in the Northern Tuli Game Reserve

### WHY MASHATU?

- Unparalleled value for money
- Easily accessible from Johannesburg. (Daily scheduled flights to Polokwane with a connecting road transfers).
- Diverse wilderness offering excellent game viewing, adventure activities as well as traditional game drives, specialist safaris, & a variety of accommodation.
- Resident leopard scientist conducting research in Mashatu

### THE RESERVE

- 75,000 acres of open un-spoilt wilderness, with diverse landscapes and eco systems.
- Will form the heart of the South Africa/Zimbabwe/Botswana Transfrontier Park.
- Largest herds of free roaming elephants on private land in Southern Africa.

### THE CAMPS

#### **Main Camp**

- 14 luxury suites.
- Children of all ages welcome.
- US\$ 415.00 rack (from 01/01/11 – 31/12/12) ppp night sharing.
- Accommodation at Mashatu Main Camp includes insect-proofed luxury suites, each with an ample and fully equipped en-suite bathroom. Sliding doors open onto the African bush, two large beds complete well-appointed rooms. Mashatu Main Camp offers a stunning viewing deck directly off the bar, together with an elevated lounge overlooking the waterhole.

#### **Tent Camp**

- 8 twin tents, each with private en suite facilities.
- No children under the age of 12.
- US\$ 285 rack (from 01/01/11 - 31/12/11) and US\$ 300.00 rack (from 01/01/12 - 31/12/12) ppp night sharing.
- Tucked away in the remote northern area of the reserve lies Mashatu Tent Camp. Small & intimate, the well appointed tents are insect-proofed, have comfortable beds and each has an en-suite shower and W.C. facility. There is an open-sided thatch deck where meals are served, as well as a traditional boma for intimate campfire dinners. This camp also has a plunge pool & bird hide over looking a water hole.

**Rate includes: En-suite accommodation, all meals and snacks, game drives conducted by experienced rangers and trackers, game walks, transfers to & from the Limpopo Valley Airfield & the Pont Drift Border Post within scheduled collection times.**

### ADVENTURE MASHATU:

- Mountain Bike Safaris & Horse Safaris, Walking Safaris.
- Specialist Predator drives,
- Cultural excursions to a local village
- Can be arranged as ad-hoc adventure activities, or as tailor-made packages in rustic satellite camps.

### HOW TO GET THERE?

- Daily scheduled flights on Airlink from Johannesburg O.R Tambo International Airport to Polokwane (formerly Pietersburg) with a connecting road transfer to the Pont Drift Border Post.
- By road: easy 5.5 - 6 hour drive from Johannesburg on tarred main roads.
